

Community Pharmacy Chlamydia Service

Community pharmacies have been previously notified about a Chlamydia screening and treatment enhanced service that is being introduced by NHS Cambridgeshire in conjunction with the Chlamydia Screening Programme. Pharmacies can also register as pick up points for condoms.

PCT provided training is compulsory for every staff member involved in each aspect of the service.

- Pharmacy Assistants can offer the screening kit distribution service and condom pick up service by attending PCT training.
- The treatment part of the service must be provided by accredited pharmacists. Pharmacists are also required to complete the CPPE package 'Sexual Health: testing and treating' to become accredited. It would be useful but is not essential to complete this package before the training event.

The pharmacy contractor has the responsibility to ensure that all staff including locums involved in providing this service have attended the PCT organised training programme.
